SCHOOL/COMMUNITY:

Windham High School is a public high school accredited by the New England Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges. The total school population for the RSU#14 Windham Raymond School Department is approximately 3,350. Windham High School has approximately 1064 students in grades 9 through 12.

Located in the Sebago Lake Region, 12 miles from Portland, Windham is a town experiencing growth due to both residential & commercial development. The community and students represent a diversified socio-economic structure.

CURRICULUM:

Every student is required to earn a minimum of 21 credits to receive a Windham High School diploma, including 4 English, 3 Social Studies, 3 Mathematics (4 beginning with class of 2014), 3 Sciences, 1 Physical Education, 1 Health, 1 Fine Arts, and must demonstrate Computer Proficiency. Vocational/Technical Education is available in conjunction with the Westbrook Regional Vocational Center or the Portland Arts and Technology High School. Students are able to access courses at area colleges and through Virtual High School.

HONORS AND ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES:

Honors mathematics courses are available in Algebra II, Functions, Statistics, & Trigonometry, and Pre-Calculus. Other Honors classes are offered in English, World History, Latin II, III, IV & V, Spanish II, III, IV & V, French III, IV & V, U.S. History, Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics I. Advanced Placement courses are available for English III AP, English IV AP, US History AP, European History AP, AP Calculus, AP Statistics, Biology II AP, Chemistry II AP, Physics II AP and AP Studio Art. If a student has received a grade of 85 or better in an honors or AP course, the course is weighted. Honors grades are weighted at 1.1 and AP courses are weighted at 1.2.
